FIT OUT FITS THE BILL AT HANGAR 100

A move to larger premises for Dallas Airmotive - aeronautical engine refurbishment specialists - meant a fit out of an empty hangar at Hurn Airport, Bournemouth.

Part of the H & S Aviation group, Dallas Airmotive called in Romsey based Spaceway following successful projects completed for other members of the group.
