



## SPACEWAY DOUBLES THE SPACE AT J W LIGHTING'S NEW HEADQUARTERS



Its ability to use creative designs to more than double the floor area at John Wilkinson Ltd's new headquarters on Downton Business Park has resulted in a major order for leading interiors company, Spaceway South. Fitted out to comply with the Disability Discrimination Act (DDA), Spaceway has turned the 2,000 sq. ft shell into a prestigious 4,500 square foot head office.

Initially approached by site architects Peter Collier Associates, following a recommendation from Wiltshire Glass, a customer that Spaceway had also relocated to Downton Business Park, Spaceway South was asked to develop a space efficient design that incorporated a mezzanine solution. Working closely with Peter Collier Associates and John Wilkinson, Spaceway designed a functional but prestigious office layout that utilised a FlooriTall two-storey mezzanine to increase the office area to 3,000 sq. ft.

Once the structural work had been completed, Spaceway then set about creating the offices by installing fully glazed Komfort partitioning, lighting and carpets. All work was carried out in line with the DDA to ensure that wheelchair users and people with disabilities have easy access to the building.

When John Wilkinson saw the finished offices, it asked Spaceway to expand their brief by installing a further mezzanine floor to create an additional 500 sq feet of storage space. To complete the storage installation, Spaceway fitted a racking system to enable John Wilkinson's to store street lighting and highway's equipment such as bollards and traffic signs and supplied a reach truck through its partnership agreement with Eurotrucks Direct (South) Ltd.
