Working to designs by leading London agency tilney shane, Spaceway was tasked with turning concepts into striking interiors at the new Antalis headquarters in Basingstoke.

DETAIL

Antalis was keen to develop an international flavour for its office suites, with the right balance between private office space and areas where meetings of both a formal and informal nature could take place.

Mark Johnson of tilney shane's design team came up with the concepts, which Spaceway then turned into actual solutions.

Wenge hardwood veneer on doors was used to contrast with matt white walls, full height Komfort Polar glass walling and modern art features.

Bespoke furniture designed by tilney shane was also produced by Spaceway, along with Natte fabric window blinds, matt slate flooring to replace carpet in the reception area and video conferencing facilities - linking the Basingstoke headquarters to its offices in Paris.

The project covered basics such as floors, ceilings and plumbing, to the installation of extremely high quality furniture, the fitting out of a gymnasium, a totally new reception area and internal decoration.
