A major refurbishment programme requiring minimal staff disruption.

DETAIL

When the Caxton Group required the complete refurbishment of their Waltham Cross premises, Spaceway South managed everything from partitioning and air conditioning to desks and seating.

The project represented a design challenge and the plans had to counter the effect of the office being long but rather narrow whilst creating an open plan environment with some division between departments. The design also had to provide much more filing space.

Spaceway overcame the difficulties by using a ceiling range which, by varying the height, provided the illusion of a more balanced office shape. The filing requirement was provided by more than 30 bays of storage wall.

In the management suite of offices, including a meeting arc and boardroom, Spaceway used Komfort Kameo 75 with aluminium framework finished in a cherry coloured paint, complemented by grey blinds.



Add dividing screens, new desking and seating, and the result was a project completed over 25 weeks in a phased programme which ensured minimal disturbance to staff and the ultimate delight of the company as a whole.
